TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

The purpose of these terms and conditions (hereafter the “**T&C**”) is to set the conditions of use of the services (hereafter the “**Services**”) offered on the Sites. These T&C apply to any variation or extension of the existing or future Sites.

Any person having access to the Site, regardless of their status (private individual or professional), their location, the methods of connection to the Site, the object and purpose of their access to the Sites is a user (hereinafter “**User**”).

1. ACCEPTANCE OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

The User is presumed to know and accept, without reservation, all of the T&C by simply browsing the Sites, whatever the digital terminal used.

The User is invited not to connect to the Websites if he does not accept these T&C.

2. AVAILABILITY OF THE SITES AND THE SERVICES
